

International Travel Regs

- **Proof of Vaccination: Required as of November 8, 2021** – All foreign national travelers (age 18 years or older) are required to prove that they have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Only limited exceptions apply. <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/noncitizens-US-air-travel.html>

- **COVID-19 Test** – All travelers ages 2 or older, regardless of citizenship or vaccination status, must show a negative result of a COVID-19 viral test taken no more than 24 hours before travel or documentation of recovery from COVID-19 before boarding a flight the United States.
